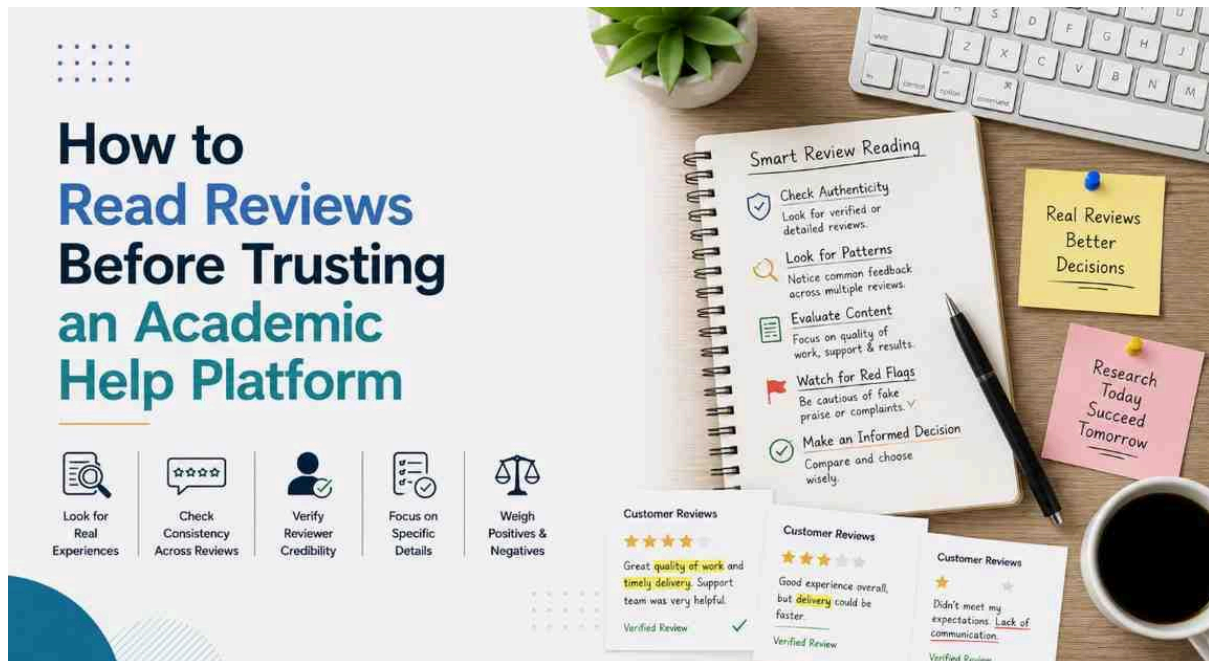


How to Read Reviews Before Trusting an Academic Help Platform
